Responsibilities for this role will include:

- Engage with families and embody our Mission Statement: "To provide an atmosphere of love, support and understanding within the camp setting, where families can renew and strengthen their relationships."
- Provide training, supervision, leadership and feedback to program staff and volunteers
- Maintain responsibility for inventory of program supplies and equipment and order supplies within the budget approved by the Board of Directors
- Ensure ongoing adherence to Park regulations, Health & Safety requirements, and Camp Policies & Procedures
- Provide administrative and general support to the Camp Director as required

The ideal candidate will have previous leadership experience, ideally in a camp, recreation, or related environment. With a strong sense of community, initiative, and teamwork, the successful candidate will be positive, enthusiastic, and motivated to deliver an exceptional experience for our Campership.

Post secondary education in recreation, education or other related field is a decided asset, as are strong customer service skills. Those candidates with demonstrated camping, canoeing, naturalist and organizational skills will be given preference and are encouraged to apply.

Current First Aid and CPR certification is required, as is a valid Driver's License. The incumbent will also be required to submit to a criminal record check and child abuse registry check.
